Teen Expectations Pt. 2

Respect each other, the space, and yourself:

- Use appropriate language
- Learn and use names of your peers and preferred pronouns
- Pick up after yourself (leave the space better than you found it)
- Be mindful of others feelings and emotions, check in with each other
- ...and I'll say it again- phones away!

If meeting these expectations becomes an challenge, talk to me. Teens may be removed from program and lose stipend if they cannot meet these expectations.

school matters

After School Matters programs are <u>safe spaces</u>.

Instructors and teens are expected to foster an inclusive program for everyone without regard to race, color, religion, gender, national origin, age, marital status, disability, pregnancy, sexual orientation, political affiliation, or belief.

Transportation Assistance



- If you entered your Ventra Transit ID on your application, ASM will load funds to your account to support with transportation to and from program up until the first payment date (July 21 for stipend programs / July 15 for internships).
- ASM provides the difference between student and full fare, so you will pay .75 for each ride.
- You will receive email notification when funds have been loaded.

How do I get paid?

After School Matters pays teens via two options: Direct Deposit or Wisely Pay by ADP Card.

Wisely Pay by ADP Card

- Free electronic banking card that allows immediate access your money each pay period. This card be used like a regular debit card.
- New to ASM, your Wisely Card will be mailed to the address you listed on your application.
- Returning teens use your Wisely card from previous session. If your card is lost or stolen, contact ADP Wisely at 1-866-313-6901.

- Wisely replacement pick up days: 7/14 & 8/11

Direct Deposit

- Payment option where your funds are electronically transferred to your checking or savings account.
- Must have a bank account.
- Sign up on your Teen Dashboard

What happens after I miss more than the absence limit?

> You won't be eligible to get any remaining stipend payments. So triple check your program schedule to make sure you can attend all the dates!
